### Paper Documents

- Photos

- Books (with any time of LGBTQ subject matter)
- Magazines (local preferred, but national publications may be accepted)
- Newspapers (local LGBTQ publications especially)
- Newspaper clippings
- Dissertations: This would also include the work or notes for the project
- Interview transcripts
- Signage (acceptance of donation based on size and available storage space)
- Research related to the North Texas LGBTQ community
- Art: unframed
- Art over 18×24 or framed art (conditional)
- Journals
- Certificates/awards
- Minutes of meetings
- Interoffice communications
- Personal letters

- Significant event memorabilia
- T-shirts
